There are various exams students take to get into the course and country of their choice. Some of the most popular, and most important international entrance exams include the **GMAT, GRE, IELTS and the TOEFL**. These are required for admission to universities and colleges in various countries across the globe. At times, the need may be a combination of one or more of these and other tests/examinations specific to that country and its education system.

### ***GMAT***

The GMAT refers to the Graduate management admission test designed specifically for those interested in applying for MBA or business management graduate programs. It is a valid and reliable predictor of your academic performance in today's graduate management classrooms. The test is geared toward looking at your aptitude and ability, not just your knowledge. More than 5,400 programs offered by more than 1,500 institutions in over 110 countries use the GMAT as part of the selection criteria. It is accepted by countries like India, UK, US, Canada, Australia etc.

## ***GRE***

The GRE or Graduate Record Exam is taken by students applying to graduate school in countries like the USA, the UK, Australia, etc. It is accepted by thousands of universities around the world. This exam measures a student's basic abilities in math, reading and essay writing. The results of this test are sent to graduate schools along with a student's application, transcripts, letters of recommendation, and statement of purpose essay.

## ***IELTS***

IELTS or International English Language Testing System is a standardised English proficiency examination taken by non-native speakers going to English speaking countries to study, work or live. IELTS is jointly owned by IELTS Australia, British Council, and Cambridge English Language Assessment Test. It is recognized by more than 9,000 organizations all around the world including educational institutions, employers, governments and professional bodies. To serve different purposes there are two types of IELTS examination: Academic and General.

## ***TOEFL***

TOEFL refers to the test of English as a foreign language which evaluates a candidate's proficiency in English. Because it is a valid and reliable test with unbiased, objective scoring, the TOEFL test confirms that a student has the English language skills necessary to succeed in an academic setting. More than 8,500 colleges, universities, and agencies in 130 countries accept TOEFL scores. It is administered at more than 4,500 test centres in 180 countries. More than 27 million people have taken the test since it began in 1964.

### **CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP 2020-2021**

Online applications are invited for selection of Indian nationals for Chinese Government Scholarship 2020-21, for pursuing following programs:

- (i) Undergraduate programs
- (ii) Master's programs
- (iii) Doctoral programs
- (iv) General Scholar programs
- (v) Senior Scholar programs.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

**(a) Applicant must be a permanent citizen of India and should be currently residing in India at the time of applying.**

#### **(b) Age Criterion:**

- i) For applying to undergraduate programs: applicant must be a high school graduate (Class XII pass) under the age of 25.
- ii) For applying to master's programs: applicant must be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35.
- iii) For applying to doctoral programs: applicant must be a master's degree holder under the age of 40.
- iv) For applying to general scholar programs: applicant must be a high school graduate i.e. he/she must have cleared Class XII (at least) under the age of 45.
- v) For applying to senior scholar programs: applicant must be a master's degree holder OR an associate professor (or above) under the age of 50.

#### **(c) Other Criterion:**

Candidates who have been abroad for the purpose of study/research/training, for the period of more than six months at a time either on a scholarship or on their own, are eligible to apply only if they have been in India for at least two years, after their return from abroad as on 24 January 2020.

3. **40 slots** are offered under the Chinese Government Scholarship. Final selection of candidates rests with the Embassy of the People's Republic of China. Nominations would be made in a proportional manner according to the number of applications received under each degree program.

4. **VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP:** Please visit [www.campuschina.org](http://www.campuschina.org) for details of value of scholarship provided by the Government of China.

5. **AIRFARE:** The Government of India will bear the cost of airfare for onward air tickets only i.e. India to China for the candidates who are finally selected for award of this scholarship.

6. **SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATIONS:**

**Candidates must necessarily apply on both the following websites to be considered for nomination by the Ministry of Human Resource Development for this scholarship:**

(i) Chinese Scholarship Council's Online Application System ([www.campuschina.org](http://www.campuschina.org)). Instructions for applying on the Chinese Scholarship Council's Online Application System are enclosed.

(ii) <http://proposal.sakshat.ac.in/scholarship> . Portal would be active from 12 December 2019 to 24 January 2020.

7. Applicants are required to upload the following documents while applying for this scholarship on <http://proposal.sakshat.ac.in/scholarship> :

(a) PDF of the application form submitted on [www.campuschina.org](http://www.campuschina.org).

(b) Self attested copy of class X mark sheet, class XII mark sheet, degree certificate (UG/PG/Doctoral as applicable). Please note that if your degree is awarded in terms of GPA, applicant must upload the official procedure adopted by the University/Institution for conversion of GPA to Percentage.

(c) Class X pass certificate as proof of age of the applicant.

(Document size: size of an individual document must be under 530 kb)

8. **CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION:** The following criteria would be adopted for nomination of the candidates:

- For undergraduate programs, merit list would be based on Class XII marks (80% weightage) and Class X marks (20% weightage).
- For Master's, Doctoral, General Scholar and Senior Scholar programs, priority for nomination would be given to candidates who have completed their last qualifying exam either from Institutes of National Importance (INI)/Central Universities (CU)/ Centrally funded Technical Institutes (CFTI)/National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) accredited institutions

**Important Notes**

(i). The study of Chinese Language Course of about one year is mandatory before starting study in relevant subject in Chinese Language. The medium of instructions/study in China is Chinese Language; hence the candidates must keep this fact in mind before submitting his/her application for Chinese Government Scholarship. No request for exemption or waiving of Chinese Language Course will be entertained after nomination/selection and candidature of applicant will be rejected summarily if he/she is not willing to study Chinese Language in China. Many programs/disciplines are taught only in Chinese Language in the Chinese university/institutions. Applicants are, therefore, advised to choose their program/discipline carefully.

- (ii). Candidate is expected to have rudimentary knowledge of prevailing geopolitical situation, culture and heritage of China.
- (iii). Canvassing in any form and suppression of any fact in the application will disqualify the candidature of the applicant.
- (iv). The final selection of the nominated candidates rests with the Government of People's Republic of China.
- (v). The applicant in employment (to which he/she wishes to return) should have an assurance from his/her employer that he/she will be granted sufficient leave if he/she is awarded this scholarship during study period in China.
- (vi). All communication will be made on candidates' registered email. It is advised that working email should be provided.

## **Instructions for Chinese Government Scholarship Information System (CGSIS)**

-For Applicants

Please carefully read the instructions before applying for the scholarship.

**Step 1:** Visit “CSC Study in China” website and click “Scholarship Application for Students” at <http://www.csc.edu.cn/studyinchina> or <http://www.campuschina.org>

Register an account through [CREATE AN ACCOUNT] and login with your account.

**Step 2: Input Personal Details.** Click “Edit Personal Details” and finish inputting personal details by filling in all the information, verifying and saving the information. After the completion of this section, return to the previous page by clicking “Finish” and start filling in your application information.

**Step 3: Select the correct “Program Category”.**

Please select Program Category “Type A”.

**Step 4: Input the correct Agency Number.**

Your Agency Number is: 3561.

**Program Category** and **Agency Number** are directly matched, both are mandatory for online application.

After inputting agency number, the matched agency name will automatically show on the page. As **Program Category** and **Agency Number** are directly matched, application processing authorities will not receive your online application if the program category or agency number are not correct.

**Step 5: Input Application Information**

Next, please move on to the section of “Language Proficiency and Study Plan” and upload “Supporting Documents” as requested, then click “Submit” to complete the application. Check each part of your application carefully before submission. Please make sure that all the information and uploaded documents are valid and accurate.

When applicants of “Type A” application choose the “Preferences of Institutes”, system will automatically match the available universities according to the selected “Student Category, Preferred teaching language and Major Applying for”. With any

inquiry concerning the available majors of each university, please visit the following website.

“Catalog of Discipline Field, First-level Discipline, Specialty” is available from the “Help”, applicants could download the file to identify the relation between Discipline and Major.

**Step 6: Once submitted, amendment cannot be made on “Personal Details” and “Application Information”.** Before the application being processed by the processing authorities, applicant can revoke the submitted application by clicking “Withdraw” and edit the application. After revoking the application, applicant must submit at second time after re-editing, or the application will not be processed. Once the application is processed, application cannot be revoked.

**Step 7:** Click” Print the Application Form” and download the form.

**Step 8:** Submit scholarship application under the requirements of the dispatching authorities (or application processing agency)
