**4. METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION**

4.1 Selection for admission to I BE 2026-2027 in GCE (IRTT) under preferential quota seats for the wards of employees of State Transport Undertakings / IRT / TDFC / PTCS and who are member of the scheme will be as detailed in Section 4.2 to 4.9.

**4.2 Admission of Academic Stream Candidates:**

The total preferential quota seats are 168 (35 % of 480)

The selection for I B. E. 2026-27 will be made on the basis of marks obtained by the eligible candidates in the prescribed subjects Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry at the qualifying examinations reduced to the base of 200 marks (Mathematics 100 marks, Physics + Chemistry=100 marks).

**4.3 Admission of Vocational Stream Candidates:**

The total available seats are 16.

The ranking will be also be as in case of HSC (Academic) candidates. The marks in prescribed subjects reduced to 100 (Related subject 100 marks, vocational subject including theory & practical 100 marks)

4.4 Ranking of candidates will be done community wise based on the total marks computed to a maximum of 200.

4.5 Ranking is done separately for Academic Stream and Vocational Stream Candidates.

4.6 A merit list will be prepared community wise based the total marks of 200.

4.7 The list of eligible candidates will be sent to Government of Tamil Nadu for approval. On approval of the merit list, the candidates will be called for counseling

4.8 In case where more than one candidate has got the same mark in the merit list the inter-se merit among such candidates shall be determined in the order of priority as specified below:

- i. Percentage of marks in Mathematics
- ii. Percentage of marks in Physics
- iii. Percentage of marks in the fourth optional subject
- iv. Date of Birth (Elder will be given preference)
- v. Random number assigned (higher value will be given preference)

4.9 Normalization of marks and inter-se merit Tamil Nadu Act

No.3 of 2007, Dt. 05.03.2007 and G. O. Ms. No. 77, HE (J2) Department, Dt. 05.04.2007. The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various boards of Authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of Tamil Nadu by adopting the method of normalization.

Example: If the highest mark secured by the student of State Board of Tamil Nadu in Physics is 100 and the highest marks secured by the students of any other Board in the same subject are 90 both the highest marks will be considered to be equal to 100. If a student of the other Board secures 60 marks in the physics when the first mark in physics in the same Board is 90 the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived below:

$$\frac{100 \times 60}{90} = 66.66$$

After normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by different Boards, the qualified students of different Boards shall be merged in to a common merit list.

#### 5. PREFERENTIAL QUOTA SEATS:

35% of branch wise sanctioned strength is reserved for preferential quota.

#### 6. ALLOCATION OF BRANCH:

7.2 All candidates will be considered for communal reservation as per Government of Tamil Nadu policy.

7.3 Candidates seeking admission against SC / SCA / ST / MBC&DNC / BC / BC (Muslims) quota should obtain the certificates of social status issued by the competent authority in the prescribed e-verified permanent community cards in Tamil Nadu.

(a) The applicants from Tamil Nadu State should have a valid permanent community certificate in the card format issued by the competent authority for SC / SCA / ST / MBC&DNC / BC in the format prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu. The permanent community card issued to ST by Tahsildars up to 11.11.1989 is valid.

(b) For communities linked with Districts the candidates should obtain their community certificate in the respective districts. Community certificates obtained from other than the respective districts will not be considered.

(c) Community certificates obtained from other state will not be considered for communal reservation.

d) Candidates who have not furnished an attested Xerox copy of the permanent community card at the time of submission of the application will be treated as belonging to 'OC'. They are further informed that in the event of such a decision, the eligibility conditions and rules prescribed for other communities will be applicable for such candidates and if such candidates do not satisfy the rules of 'OC' candidates, their applications are liable to be rejected. No correspondence in this connection will be entertained.

(d) SC / SCA / ST / MBC&DNC / BC / BC (Muslim) candidates are eligible for selection under open competition in addition to the reservation made for them.

(e) At the time of admission, the candidates should produce the original community certificate card along with an attested Xerox copy of the same.

7.4 Counselling will be held at Government College of Engineering, Erode (IRTT), 638 316 at specified date and time.

7.5 Candidates will be called for counselling as per their rank and individual call letters will be sent by post.

7.6 An intimation for counselling does not guarantee for admission since more number of candidates are called than the actual number of vacancies.

7.7 If the ranking of candidate gets altered due to re totaling / revaluation of marks, the candidate can attend the counselling as per the new marks and rank, though the call letter specifies different date, which is as per original mark.

7.8 Due to unavoidable circumstances, if a candidate is unable to attend the counselling on the specified date his / her parent can attend the counselling on behalf of the him / her and the parents' decision will be binding on the candidate.

7.9 Candidates who do not attend the counselling on the date specified by the Institute may have to forgo the claim of admission

7.10 Due to unforeseen reasons, if a candidate could not attend the counselling on the specified date and time, the candidate can attend on a subsequent date / time, during the counselling.
