#### TEAM FORMATION

- 1) All team members should be from same college; no inter-college teams are allowed. However, members from different branches of the same college/ institute are encouraged to form a team.
- 2) Each team would mandatorily comprise of 6 members including the team leader.
- 3) Each team must have AT LEAST ONE FEMALE TEAM MEMBER.
- 4) As the software edition of the hackathon is digital product development competition, majority of the team members MUST be well versed with programming skills. For the hardware edition, we encourage multi-disciplinary teams – which means your team should have a good mix of Mechanical Engineers, Electronic Engineers, Product Designers and Programmers, etc.
